**Melka "Mekerra"** Knights Valley - Aromatics abound with white plums, honeysuckle, and touch of earthiness. This wine pops on the nose and delivers gorgeous purity and minerality alongside elegance and vibrancy. The finish is long and lingering. 100% Sauvignon Blanc, 100% Barrel Fermented, 100% Knights Valley

#### \$175

**Melka "Majestique" Paso Robles -** The vineyard is a patchwork of undulating, steep, limestone hillsides five miles west of Paso Robles. The soils are very un-California like -calcareous and extreme. The wine reflects the high pH soils expressing purity, finesse and length.

## \$350

**Melka "Metisse" Napa Valley -** A fruit profile of dark cherry and plum, with tobacco, black licorice and cola, all leaping from the glass. The wine is iron-rich, extremely lush and vibrant showing incredible depth with licorice, spice and minerality dominating the palate. The wine carries through with a very long finish that continues to linger and begs you to revisit for another sip.

## \$150

**Elwood Pinot2014/2015 -** 100% PINOT NOIR from a prominent single vineyard in the beautiful hills of Santa Maria Valley. The nose offers subtle floral notes, with hints of creme brulee, earth and lavender. The attack is concentrated on dark fruit, ripe tobacco, and hints of citrus and dark chocolate s'mores. Aged 20 months in 30% new french oak barrels, the 2015 Coalesce allows you to enjoy it now or lay it down for 20 years to come.

# \$110

Ashes & Diamonds Cab Franc - 2016 was the coolest of the three years, making for the most "Loire-esque" Cabernet Franc, while 2017 was the warmest, showcasing more spice notes and roundness. Last, but not least, 2018 feels like it has a little bit of both—the 2017 spice notes on the finish, the structure and earthiness of 2016— illustrating just what a complete wine the 2018 vintage is.
